"Angels Among Us"

The theme song for our Advent season, the days leading up to Christmas Day, is called "Angels Among Us" and was made famous by singing group Alabama. But it wasn't written by them, it was created by a songwriter named Becky Hobbs. She had premonitions in the mid 1980's that she might be about to die. Then on her birthday in 1986 she and her band were in a serious automobile accident in which

an 18-wheeler semi came rushing through a red light at an intersection, slammed into and totaled their van. They all survived and walked away from the accident with minor injuries. Becky said that she felt as if she'd been warned and delivered because of her guardian angel which kept them safe that day on the road.

After arriving back home she sat down at her piano and started writing, immediately having the title and many of the verses and melody but wasn't able to complete the song until about 10 years later. In 1993 she and co-writer, Don Goodman, finished the song, and submitted it to Randy Owen of Alabama, and it has impacted people around the world since then.

When I first heard the song, I imagined heavenly beings descending to keep an eye and protective presence as we imagine angels will sometimes do. In addition to the mysterious presence of unseen beings, when you listen closely to the lyrics, you find that the people about us sometimes serve as God's messengers of good news and healing ... and sometimes we just might be the "angel/messenger" God is using to touch another life.

As we continue to approach Christmas Day, watch for and thank God for the special blessings that come your way every day ... and watch for opportunities, great and small, to touch and bless another person's life. The hope in all our actions is that God would be made known, and that others would find the path back to claiming and following Jesus the Christ.
